[Live Homework Help](#)

Help from real, live tutors via the Internet. This program is for 4th to 12th grade students and is available every day from 3 P.M. to 8 P.M. for up to 20 minutes of one-on-one help. Students can get help in math, science, social studies or English.

[EBSCO NovelList K-8](#) – Discover great books to read. This database of fiction titles is aimed at the K-8 population. Full-text reviews and book talks also provided for selected young adult and children’s titles. It allows users to search by author, title, series, theme or topic.

[EBSCO Searchasaurus](#) – Learn how to search with Searchasaurus! This website is designed for elementary school children and contains a dictionary, encyclopedia, pictures, magazine and newspaper articles, plus a ‘visual’ search engine to find related topics.

[EBSCO Middle Search Plus](#) – Find magazine articles, images, biographies, historical essays, primary source documents, maps, flags, and more in this database of resources for 4th to 9th grade students. Also includes the *Our States* reference book series.

[Gale Discovering Collection](#) – Consult this all-in-one resource that covers science, geography, world and U.S. history, culture, and literature. For middle to high school students.

[Gale WebFeet](#) – Need a good website fast? Try this subject guide composed of thousands of descriptions of Websites that have been selected by a team of librarians, educators, subject area specialists, and editors for their quality, credibility, and usefulness. (Use the first 5 digits of your library card barcode number as the password.)

[Greenwood Daily Life Online](#)

Browse by time period, region, or subject. Understand historical context with chronologies and timelines based on the 6 volume *Greenwood Encyclopedia of Daily Life* and the 34 volume *Daily Life Through History* series.

[Grolier Kids Online](#) - This database includes encyclopedia articles, magazines, an interactive atlas, and a dictionary. Other subject-specific encyclopedias focus on biographies, the history of the United States and science projects. Keep up with current events using ‘kid-friendly news.’

[Grolier New Book of Knowledge](#) – Based on the *New Book of Knowledge* this cool site has serious information for young students who are learning to use online resources for research. It includes carefully screened Web links. Homework help included.

[Tumble Book Library](#) – Tumble Book Library is for children who love picture books. Here they can find animated, ‘talking’ picture books, puzzles, and educational games, as well as books in other languages. There is language arts support in the form of book annotations, vocabulary lessons, reading comprehension quizzes, book reviews and more.
