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Live Homework Help - Help from real, live tutors via the Internet. This program is for 4th to 12th grade students and is available every day from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. for up to 20 minutes of one-on-one help. Students can get help in math, science, social studies or English.

Credo – This database is an essential tool for homework and research projects. It includes full text reference sources covering every major topic. Includes over 60,000 images, audio files, maps, citations and much more.

Gale’s History Resource Center: Modern World – A comprehensive online collection of modern world historical information gathered into one source as an integrated collection of full-text periodicals, reference works, and primary source documents for upper level study. It has extensive inter-linking and cross-referencing of basic information, evidence and analyses.

Gale’s History Resource Center U.S. – A comprehensive online collection of United States historical information gathered into one source as an integrated collection of full-text periodicals, reference works, and primary source documents.
