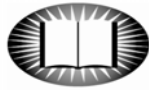

The Gold Coast Public Library has something for everyone. A wide variety of collections, programs, and services and a talented, friendly staff are available to assist you. Today's libraries are places where lifelong learning begins!

Print and audio-visual materials include bestselling titles, classic older fiction, popular non-fiction, DVD films, audiobooks on CD, 'Playaway' MP3s, and a CD Music collection.

The Virtual Library is a compilation of electronic resources that can fulfill virtually any reference need. These Internet-accessible databases can be used from home 24 hours a day, 7 days a week!

Children will enjoy browsing picture books, easy readers, popular series fiction, classic fiction and non-fiction books. In addition, there are DVD films and music CDs for their entertainment and enjoyment.

Museum Passes are available for borrowing to one of many area museums.

GETTING A LIBRARY CARD

Registration forms are available at the Circulation Desk; bring a driver's license, tax, or utility bill as proof of residence.

PRINT COLLECTION

- Fiction and non-fiction books, including bestsellers and large-print books.
- Young Adult Fiction, series Fiction and graphic novel collection.
- Popular magazines for adults and children; local and national newspapers.
- Ability to place requests on most items and borrow from other libraries using ALISCat online at: www.alisweb.org

AUDIO-VISUAL COLLECTION

- Films for children and adults (DVDs).
- Audiobooks for children and adults, both on CDs, 'Playaway' MP3s, and downloadable audiobooks from the Nassau Digital Doorway. You can even borrow an MP3 player and FM car adapter for an 'On the Go' experience.

ELECTRONIC COLLECTION

The Virtual Library is an extensive collection of more than 50 online subscription resources. There are sites for students of all ages, history buffs, investors and more, plus a site with multi-media picture books for children!

PUBLIC ACCESS COMPUTERS

The library has several personal computers for public use. They offer Internet access, office suite software, and network printing.

REFERENCE SERVICES

In addition to offering in-house and telephone reference assistance, patrons may choose to use Nassau County's *Live Librarian* virtual reference service, or chat with a tutor at *Homework Help* online.

LOWER LEVEL: Children's collection, Story-Time Stairs, restrooms, water fountain.

UPPER LEVEL: Adult collection, Young Adult 'Lounge,' public access computers, copy machine.

GROUND LEVEL: Circulation Desk.

The Library is fully accessible. A lift is available for people who need help with stairs.

PARKING

The parking lot belongs to the Town of Oyster Bay. Be sure to park in the 2-hour spaces located in the center of the lot or in long-term *unrestricted* parking at the south end of the lot. You may park in long-term *restricted* parking on weekends and evenings. However, a TOB sticker is required during weekday business hours.
