

If you are have trouble downloading to a library-owned MP3 player, bring it back to the library and the title can be downloaded for you.

The library's MP3 players will bookmark for you.

With certain titles from the Digital Doorway, you can burn audio CDs. You will need several CDs in order to fully transfer a book to CD.

## eBooks

eBooks are electronic versions of books that can be read on personal computers or mobile devices. Fiction and non-fiction titles can be downloaded to an eBook reader from the Nassau Digital Doorway. The process is similar to downloading audiobooks; log in using your Gold Coast Public Library barcode number and select the titles you'd like to read.

Not every eBook reader supports the ePub and PDF formats of Digital Doorway eBooks; consult the Device Resource Center to see a list of compatible devices. Amazon's Kindle and Kindle DX are proprietary devices and are not compatible; Amazon eBooks are in a proprietary format not readable on non-Kindle devices.

Downloadable eBooks require the Adobe Digital Editions software. It can be downloaded for free from a link on the Digital Doorway site and is available for both PCs and Macs. Follow the 'Setup Assistant' to activate an Adobe ID on each device.

Up to 5 eBooks may be downloaded at one time. At the end of the 14-day loan period, eBooks 'expire' and can no longer be read; you may want to reserve them again, but you will want to remove them from your player in order to free up storage space for more eBooks.

An eBook may be reserved if currently 'checked out' to another person.

## Troubleshooting Tips

If your Audio CD is not working:

- Check the disk to be sure it is free of fingerprints, smudges or scratches. Try using alcohol and a soft cloth to clean the disk.

If your Playaway is not working:

- Check the battery first, it may need to be replaced; return the player to the library for a new one.
- Make sure the headphones are fully plugged into the player.
- Turn the player off and on again to reset the player.

If you cannot download or play an audiobook from the Digital Doorway:

- Make sure the Media Console was installed properly on your PC.
- Check to make sure the title you downloaded is compatible with your player. Did you select a file format for PC or Mac?
- Macintosh computers require iTunes and a different version of the Media Console; check to be sure you selected the correct console.
- When using Creative Zen MP3 players, use the USB port on your CPU instead of on the monitor.
- If your borrowed MP3 player does not work properly, check to make sure it is fully-charged.

Audiobooks and eBooks make it easy to keep up with the reading you love while keeping pace with your hectic life. Discover the many ways you can enjoy books in this format: commuting, vacationing, exercising, and driving.

Your Gold Coast Public Library Card is your passport to enjoying Mobile Reading. Come in to browse the selection of titles available on CD or Playaway, and ask about how to download titles to your own computers, MP3 players, iPods and 'smart' phones or eBook readers.

### Audiobooks on CD



Perfect for the technophobe, the audiobook on CD is easy to use in cars or computers. A wide variety of titles is available in the Library; many more can be borrowed via inter-library loan. Check [www.alisweb.org](http://www.alisweb.org) for the titles you want.

Audiobooks on CD may be checked out for 28 days.

## Playaways

Playaways are the most simple and immediate way to enjoy audiobooks, combining a wide variety of content with an easy-to-use player in one small unit. When you pick up your Playaway, all you have to do is press 'play' to start listening – there is no need for a separate player. Use your own earbuds or ask for a set.

Each Playaway contains an entire book with up to 80 hours of playing time. A Playaway weighs only 2 ounces and can easily fit in a pocket.

Playaways have a universal headphone jack that can be used with a number of mobility accessories including portable speakers, FM transmitters, and audio cables to listen in virtually any environment. Enjoy Playaways in your car by borrowing an FM wireless transmitter. They are also safe for air travel.

Playaways may be checked out for 28 days.

### Nassau Digital Doorway

Download audiobooks and eBooks to a computer; use your own MP3 or iPod player or 'smart' phone to enjoy mobile reading.

Visit [www.goldcoastlibrary.org](http://www.goldcoastlibrary.org) and click on the link for Digital Doorway. You will be asked to enter your car library barcode, so make sure you have your card handy!

## Audiobooks

The first time you visit Nassau Digital Doorway you will need to download the Media Console software for your PC or Mac. The software is free and safe for downloading. Once you have downloaded the Media Console, browse the collection of titles.

Titles are available in a variety of file formats, so check the icons to be sure the title you want is available for download onto your PC or Mac for playing on an MP3 player or iPod.

'Reading' audiobooks on a PC requires the use of the Windows Media Player or the Overdrive Media Console.

You can place a reserve on items that are currently checked out. When ready, you will receive an email.

Audiobooks may be checked out for 7 days, eBooks for 14 days. Once the loan period is up, the audiobook or eBook is no longer readable. To save room on your computer, MP3 player, iPod, or eBook reader, delete the title when finished.

If you own a PC but not an MP3 player, you may borrow an MP3 player with headphones from the library. You may also borrow an FM wireless transmitter to use while in your car.

MP3 players may be borrowed for 21 days; FM transmitters may be borrowed for 28 days.
